CONFERENCE LOCATION - TRAVEMÜNDE



Travemünde¹ is a borough of Lübeck, Germany, located at the mouth of the river Trave in Lübeck Bay. Originally built as a fortress by Henry the Lion, Duke of Saxony, in the 12th century to guard the mouth of the Trave, it became a town in 1317 and passed in 1329 into the possession of the free city of Lübeck, to which it has since belonged. Its fortifications were demolished in 1807.

A seaside resort since 1802, Travemünde is Germany's largest ferry port on the Baltic Sea with connections to Sweden, Finland, Russia, Latvia and Estonia. Home to the oldest lighthouse, dating from 1539, on the German Baltic coast, another attraction of Travemünde is the Flying P-Liner "Passat", a museum ship anchored in the mouth of the Trave.

Travemünde is also famous for its annual Travemünder Woche, a traditional sailing race week in Northern Europe, and its annual Sand festival known as the Sand World.

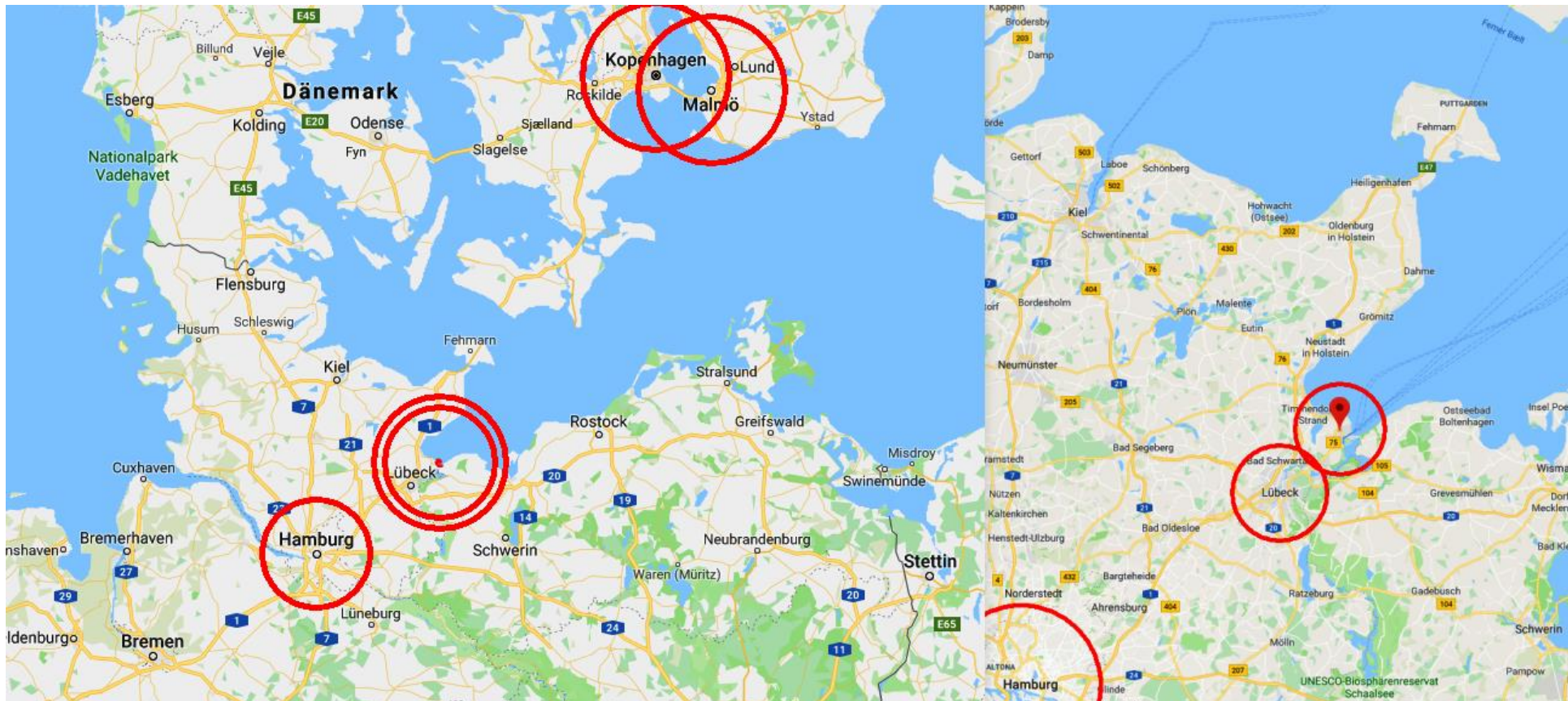

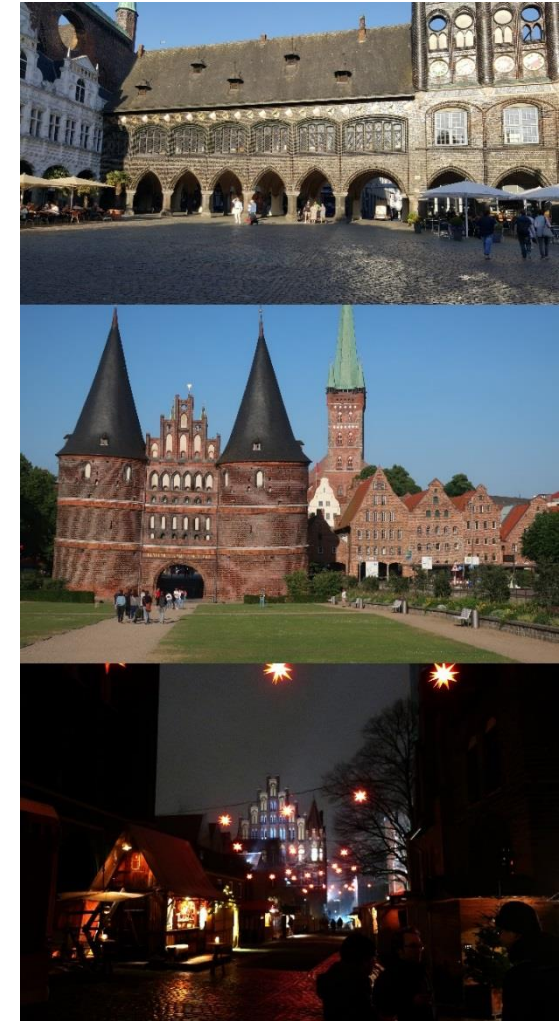


CITY OF LÜBECK (UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE)

She is the sister ship of the "PEKING" - now bought back to Germany and is under reconstruction. When finished she will be a further pride of Hansestadt Hamburg.

Another sister ship, the "PAMIR," was lost at high seas in 1957 – still trading under sail at that time.

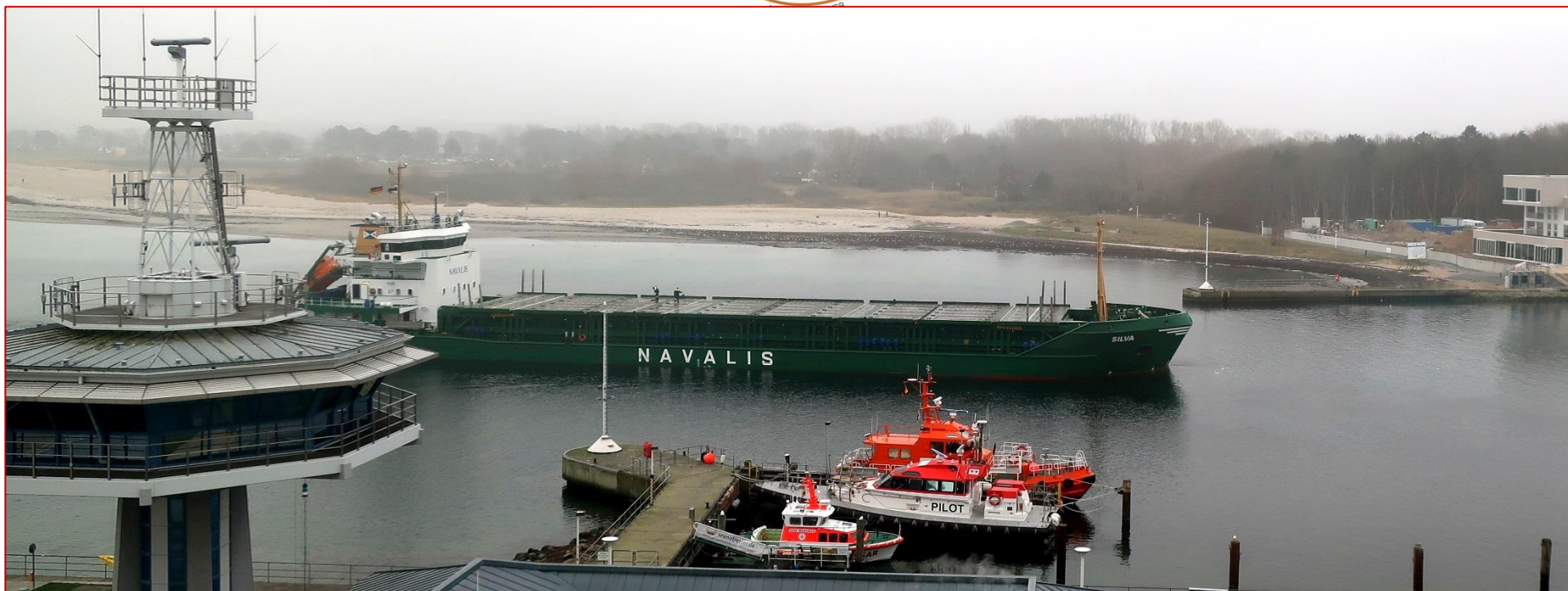
